# Our Results

## Results

### 323 Students Graduated...1,800 graduates to date

Our student body includes justice-impacted and homeless individuals. Over 44% have criminal justice involvement, more than 45% have experienced homelessness, and 90% are people of color reflecting our commitment to marginalized population.

### 100% of Students Graduate as Certified Welders

Every single student passed their welding certification skills test this year. We are pleased to report that 100% of our students are certified welders.



## Expanding Our Reach

We launched a third Mobile Training Center this year, expanding services to additional cities in Los Angeles County and testing the waters in Orange County.

The Orange County launch was so successful, we plan to launch a fourth mobile training center in 2026, focused solely on Orange County communities.

These expansions allow us to meet students where they are and remove transportation barriers to high-quality career training.



## Student Story

"I would still be sitting behind bars if they did not give me the opportunity to be a part of the program. I was lost, shy and nervous. I have not met a new person or been outside for many years.

I felt so loved and cared for. I gained 20 pounds from the wonderful lunches they provided.

Within a week of completing the course, I got employed. I have completed my 90-day review and even got a raise. Without Reignite hope, I would not be released from prison, employed and most importantly doing the right thing."


### Financial Summary

Thanks to the generosity of our many donors, ReIGNITE Hope maintains a strong financial foundation, positioning us to give more men and women what every person needs...hope and a future.






# Our Student Population

Over 44% of our student population have been incarcerated at some point in their life. 17% are currently on parole. According to the Office of U.S. Courts, an astonishing 93% of ex-offenders who secured employment within two years of their release successfully integrated back into society and did not return to prison.
